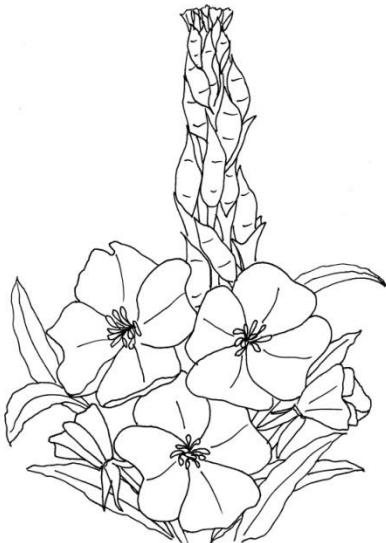


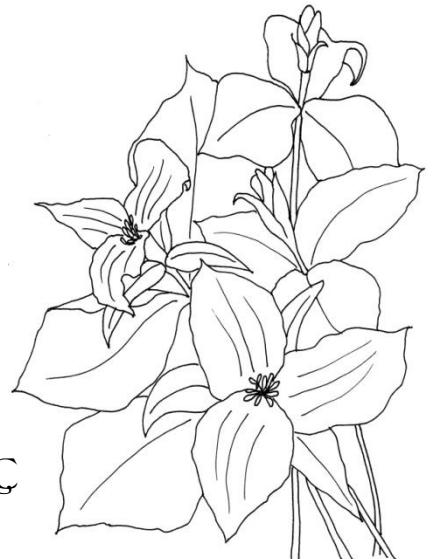

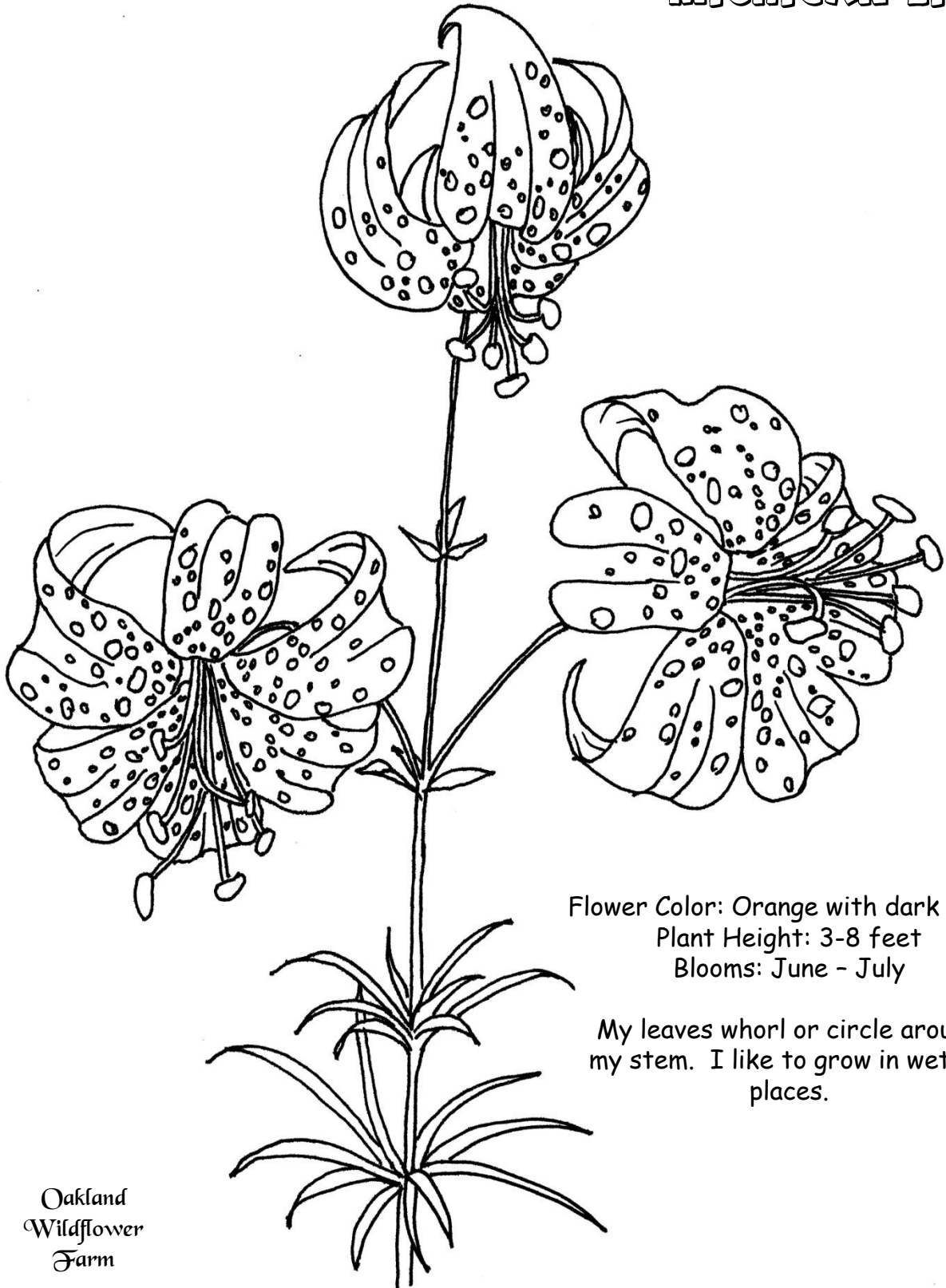


Please remember that many native plants are protected by law and picking is not allowed, instead take only pictures and leave only footprints.

Flower Color: Orange with dark spots
Plant Height: 3-8 feet
Blooms: June - July

My leaves whorl or circle around
my stem. I like to grow in wetter
places.

OENOTHERA BIENNIS

COMMON EVENING PRIMROSE

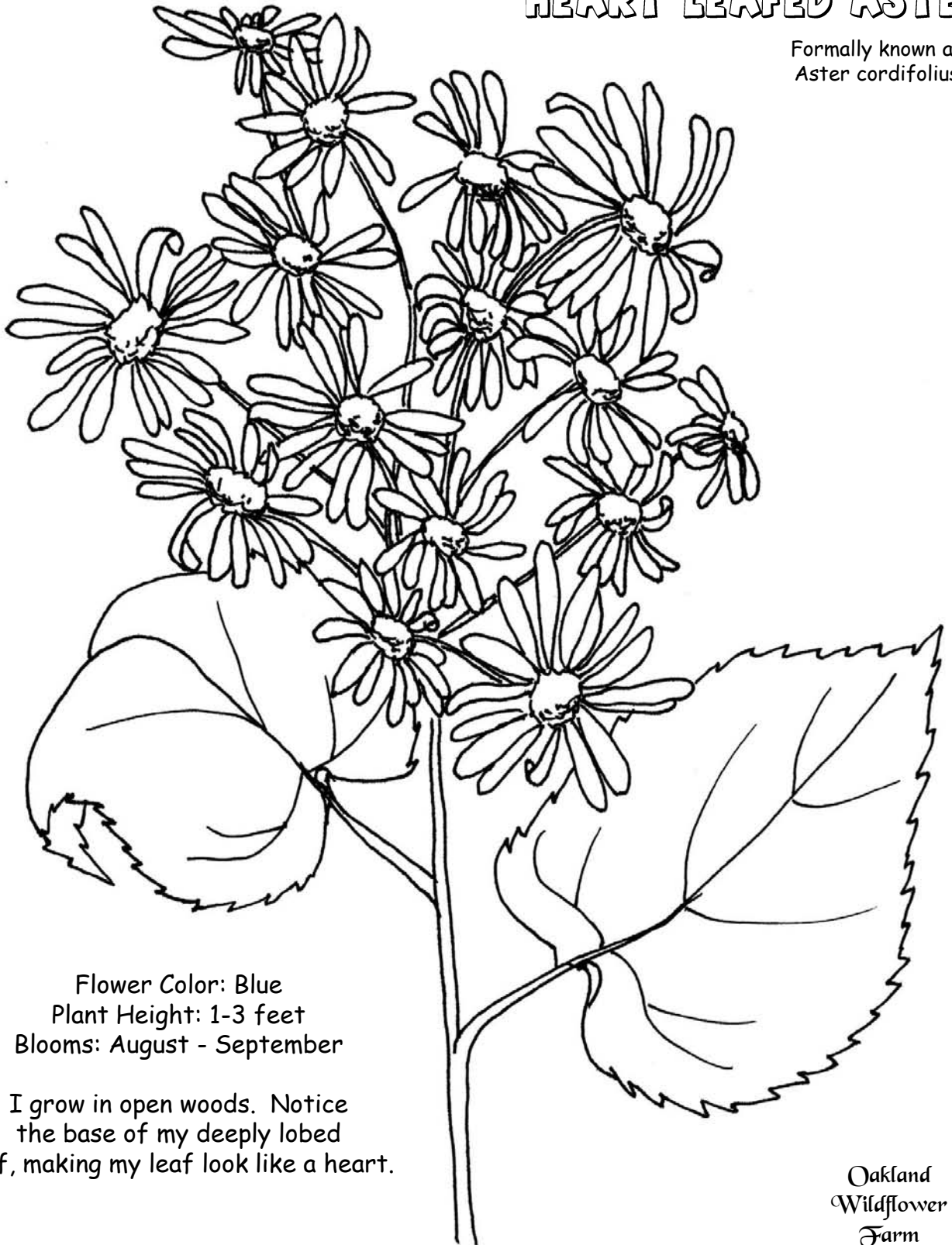
Flower Color: Yellow
Plant Height: 1 - 5 feet
Blooms: June - September

I can be found along road sides. I like to bloom on cloudy days or just before sunset, so that I can attract night flying moths.



SYMPHYOTRICHUM CORDIFOLIUM HEART LEAFED ASTER

Aster cordifolius



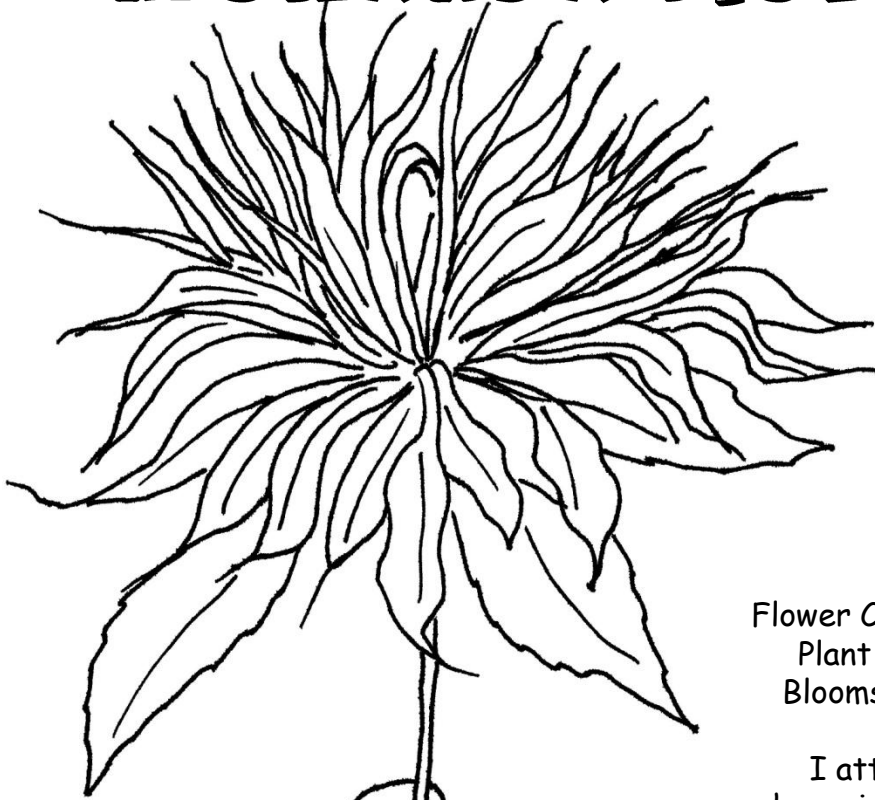
Flower Color: Blue
Plant Height: 1-3 feet
Blooms: August - September

I grow in open woods. Notice
the base of my deeply lobed

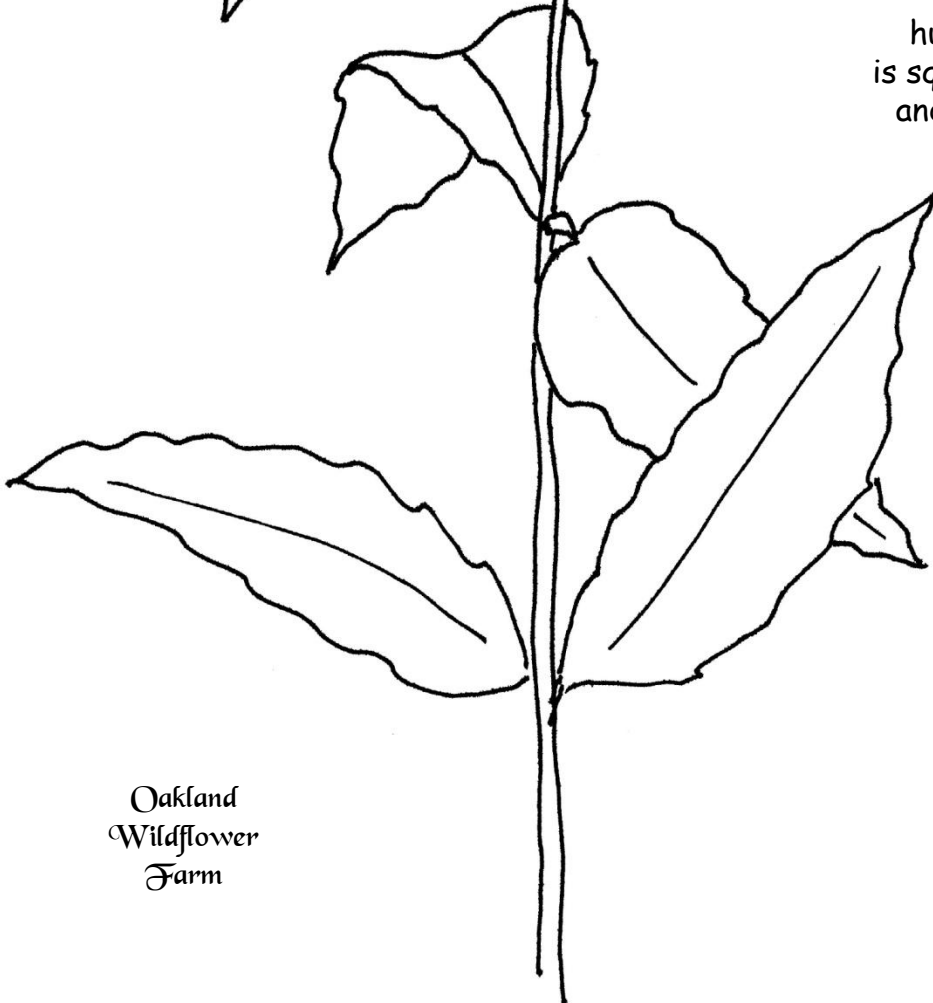
MONARDA FISTULOSA

Plant Height: 2 feet
Blooms: June - August

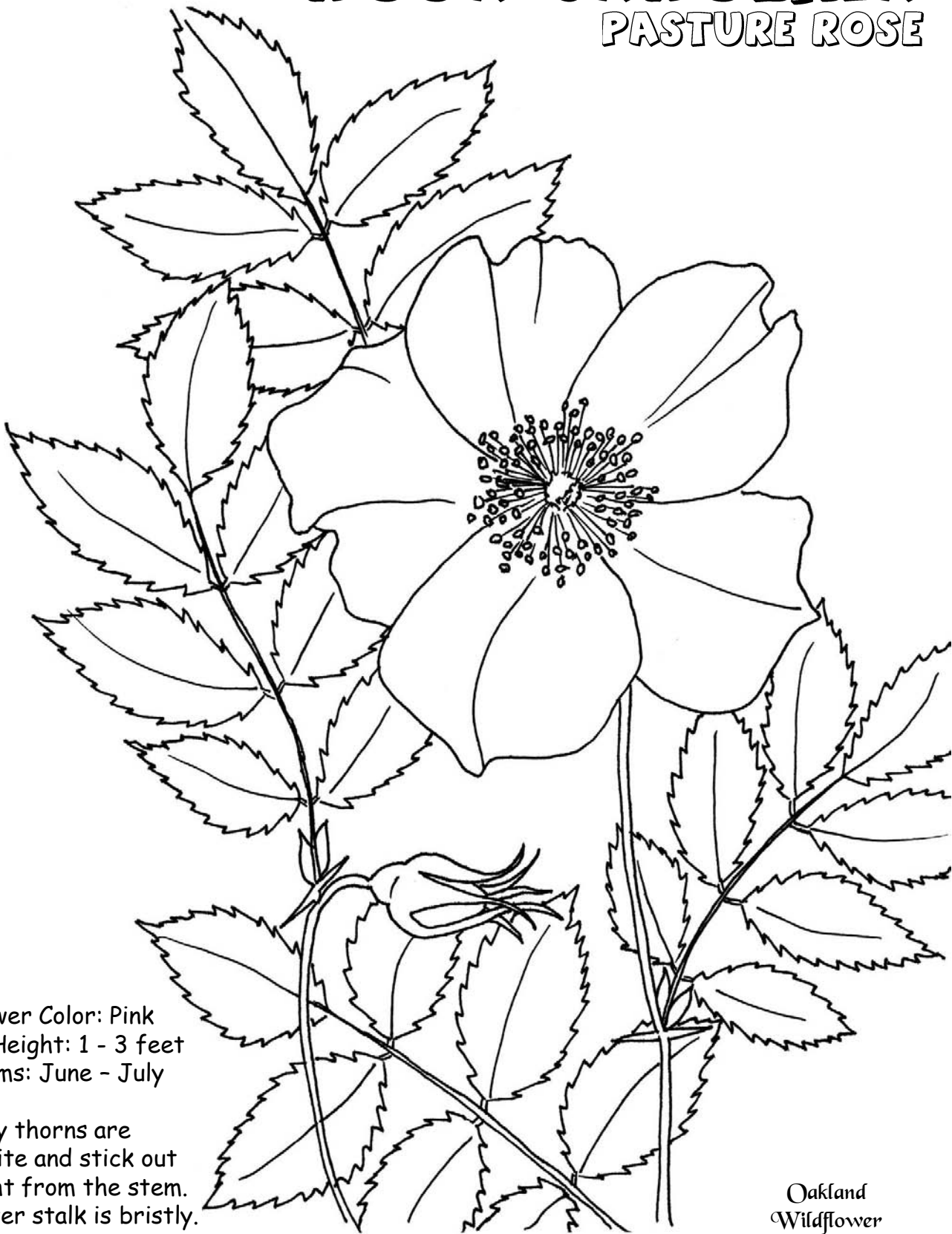
I attract bees and hummingbirds. My stem is square. Gently tear a leaf and enjoy my minty smell.

Flower Color: Pink
Plant Height: 1 - 3 feet
Blooms: June - July

My thorns are
opposite and stick out
straight from the stem.
My flower stalk is bristly.

CARDINAL FLOWER

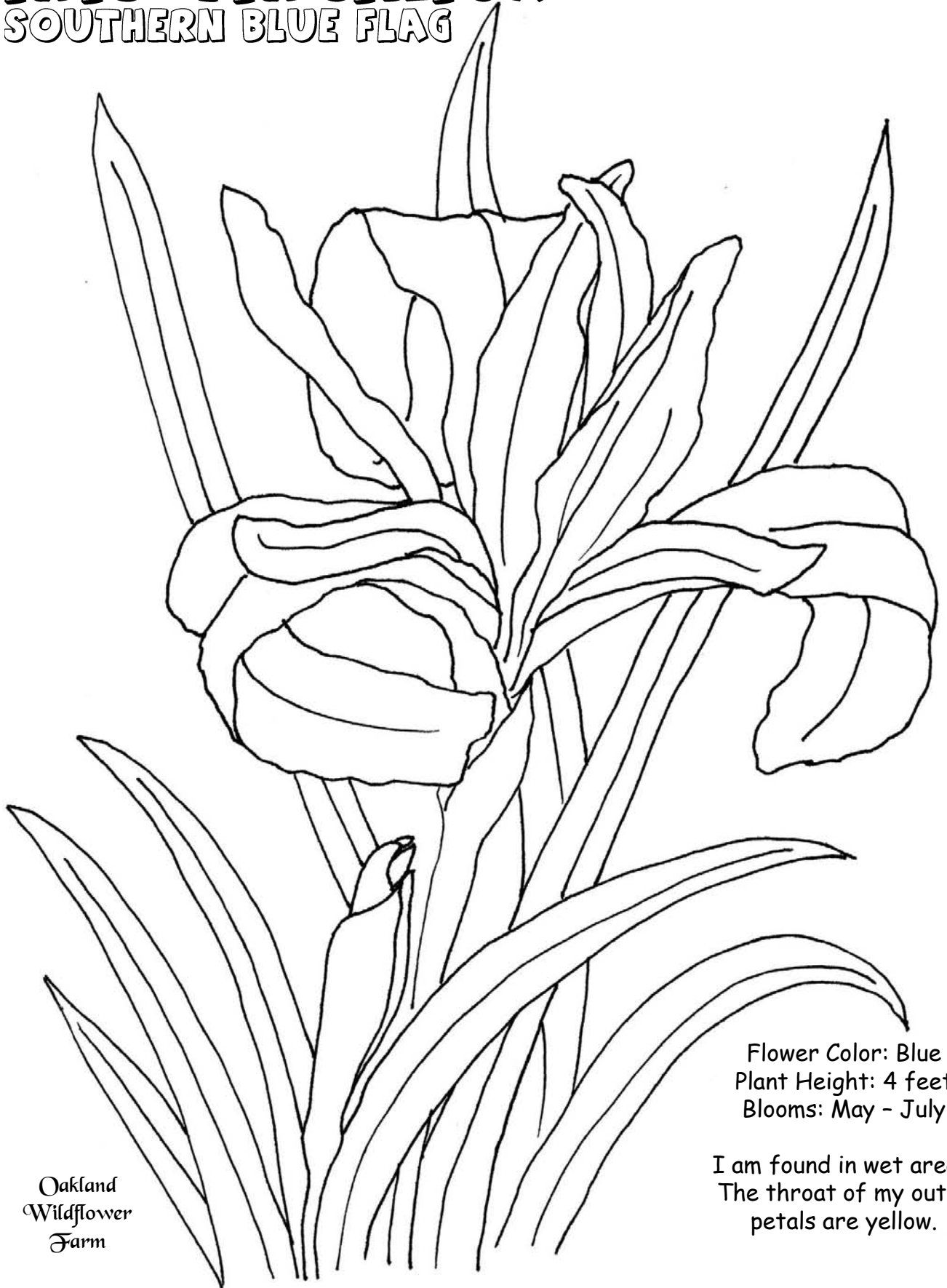
Flower Color: Red
Plant Height: 2 - 4 feet
Blooms: July - September

I like to grow in wetter soil.
I attract lots of insects, but I
am pollinated by hummingbirds.

SOUTHERN BLUE FLAG



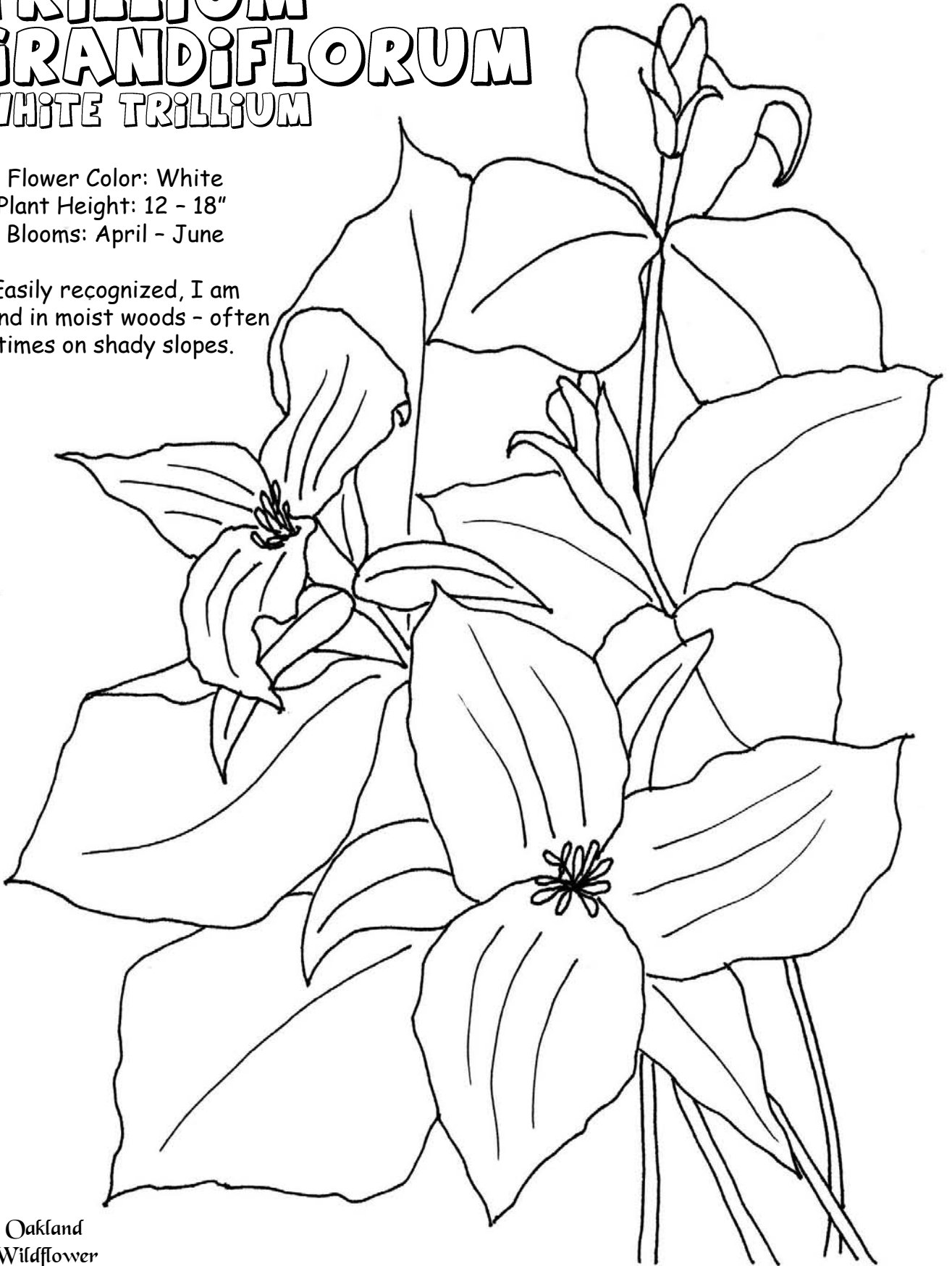
Flower Color: Blue
Plant Height: 4 feet
Blooms: May - July

I am found in wet areas.
The throat of my outer
petals are yellow.

TRILLIUM GRANDIFLORUM WHITE TRILLIUM

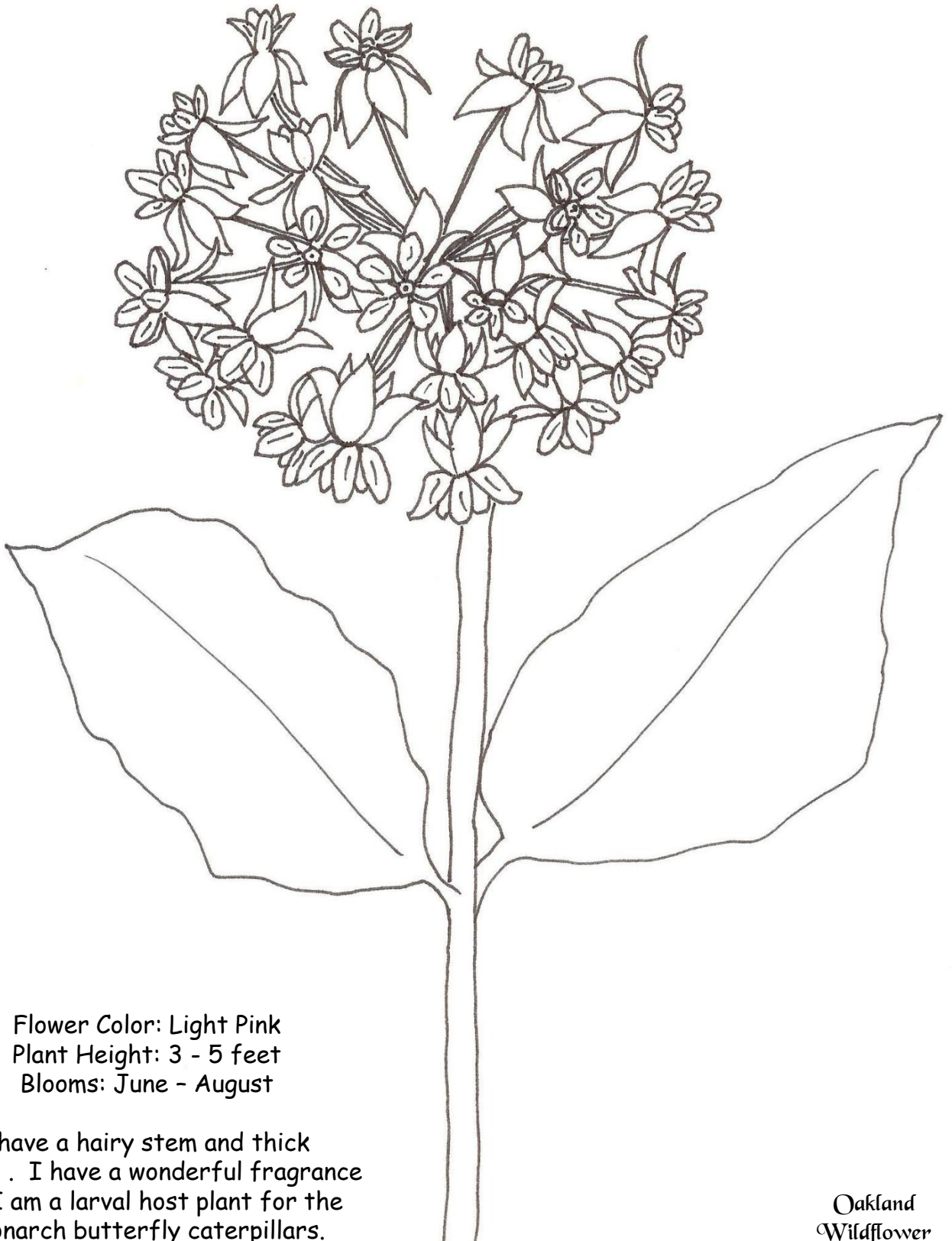
Flower Color: White
Plant Height: 12 - 18"
Blooms: April - June

Easily recognized, I am
found in moist woods - often
times on shady slopes.

Flower Color: Light Pink
Plant Height: 3 - 5 feet
Blooms: June - August

I have a hairy stem and thick leaves . I have a wonderful fragrance and I am a larval host plant for the Monarch butterfly caterpillars.
