Purchase nursery-propagated native plants in 4" quart pots with full green top growth, 1-year to 2-year growth. Plants are \$4.25 each or 12+ (a tray of same species) at \$3.75 each.

Hints For Giving Your New Plants A Good Start

- Plants should be planted in the ground 1-foot on center.
- Remove all weeds and weed seed prior to planting. Loosen dirt to allow easier root penetration.
- Water well at planting and re-water as necessary until plant recovers from shock of transplanting.
- If unable to plant right away, store plants in shady location and keep watered as necessary.
- To ensure good root system, remove spent blossoms at end of season before they can go to seed.
