Apply today. You may be the lucky winner of a landscape makeover.

One lucky homeowner will be selected for a native plant makeover. Wild Ones provides up to \$750 worth of native plants and other landscape materials, the services of a professional native landscape designer and volunteers to install the landscape.

The homeowner, with advice from Wild Ones, prepares the site for planting in fall 2009. Planting day is Saturday, June 12, 2010.

To be eligible for the native landscape makeover, participants must:

- ☼ Own a home within the boundaries of Green Bay, Ashwaubenon, Allouez, Bellevue, De Pere or Howard.
- ☼ Agree to use only native plants in the project area.
- ☼ Have a makeover area visible from the street and *at least* 10 feet by 10 feet (or at least 100 square feet).
- ☼ Prepare the site for planting prior to October 30, 2009.
- ☼ Agree to maintain planted area, keeping it free of weeds and preventing damage to plants.
- ☼ Agree to allow visits by Wild Ones and other project sponsors and assist in educational outreach including media interviews, having photos of their project used in display and printed materials and display a permanent Wild Ones sign provided by Wild Ones.
